

Highline Community College Foundation Scholarships, 2010-2011

MERIT BASED

Des Moines Rotary International Leadership and Service Scholarship - \$2,500

- 30 or more lower division credits earned in an associate degree program
- Shows evidence of leadership and service at Highline, in the community, at work, volunteering, in the classroom, or as a club or organization member
- Current Highline student

Federal Way Rotary Scholarship - \$1,500

- Resident of Federal Way
- High academic achievement with demonstrated leadership skills.
Scholarship will be awarded on 40 percent need, 10 percent community service, 20 percent academic merit, 20 percent leadership, and 10 percent interview, if conducted.
- Financial need

Highline Foundation Director's Scholarship -\$2,250

- Currently enrolled in a transfer business degree program
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Current Highline students

Leona Hickman Educational Trust Scholarship - \$2,500

- Current residents of King County, Washington for the preceding two years.
- Obtaining transfer degrees (AA or AS), AAS, or a Certificate of Completion, maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA.
- Financial need

Stella Larson Endowment - 2 @ \$1,500

- Resident of the state of Washington for 7 years
- Financial need
- Entering Student with a minimum GPA 3.0
- Must be a graduate of Tukwila or Renton School District

NEED BASED

Bob and Eleanor Baugher Endowed Scholarship - \$500

- Financial Need
- Applicant must working toward a degree with an emphasis on working with the elderly
- GPA of 2.5 or greater

Burien Challenge to Excellence Scholarship - \$1,000

- Resident of the Burien/North Highline area, who has overcome significant obstacles in their life
- English is not the primary language spoken.
- Financial need
- Clear goals for continuing on to a university to obtain a Bachelors Degree
- Current Highline student

Colleena Silba Memorial Scholarhsip - \$1,000

- For a woman who has removed herself from an abusive relationship and is studying to build a career in a computer science-related field
- Strong financial need
- Minimum of 12 credits per quarter
- Minimum 2.5 GPA

Eddie Black Endowed Memorial - \$500

- Applicants must be enrolled in a program relating to counseling (e.g., Social Sciences, Human Services, Administration of Justice)
- Financial need
- Minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Resident of Washington state for at least one year.
- Current Highline students

- Difficulty with school
- Demonstrate a positive attitude in their academic pursuit and career focus.
- Strong financial need

Highline Exchange Club "Helping Hands" Scholarship - \$500

- Difficulty with school
- Demonstrate a positive attitude in their academic pursuit and career focus.
- Strong financial need

Keybank Student Success Scholarship - \$2,000

- Pursuing degrees or certificates in business or accounting
- Minimum high school or college GPA of 2.0
- Financial need

The Exchange Club of Highline's Les Rowley Scholarship- \$1,000

- For "turnaround" students who may have had difficulty with school
- Demonstrate a new, positive attitude in their academic pursuit and career focus.

Puget Sound Angler's Scholarship - \$1,000

- A graduating senior/or a full-time Highline Community College student
- Involved in the PSSC Seahurst Marine program/and or volunteered at the HCC Marine Science and Technology Center (MaST)
- Minimum of 12 credits per quarter, during the period of the scholarship
- A minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Continued funding available for a returning student and may be used for tuition, books and misc expenses.

Pat Anderson Endowment - \$1,000

- Strong statement of financial need.
- Completed 30 + credits at HCC
- Minimum GPA 3.2

Ruth Reilly Endowed Scholarship - \$1,000

- Currently enrolled in the Paralegal Program
- Student must be a United States Citizen and a single mother
- Minimum college GPA of 3.0.

Soroptimist International Seattle, South Endowed Scholarship - \$700

- Head of household
- Well-defined educational goal
- Financial need
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Meet with the Soroptimists.
- Current Highline students

South Puget Sound Chinese Language School - \$750

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Financial need
- Plans to transfer to a 4 year university

Vern and Jean Warmbo New Beginnings Scholarship - \$2,400

- Past substance addiction struggles
- A written document with references will be required to substantiate the problem and resolution.
- Student must display a willingness to create a “new beginning.”

PROGRAM BASED

Anna M. Rundquist Memorial Scholarship - \$2,000

- Applicant must be graduating from Highline spring quarter 2010
- Must be transferring to a 4-year University
- Accepted to the nursing program

Breeders Theater Scholarship - up to \$1,500 (Maximum of \$500 per quarter)

- Performing arts demonstrated through performance, composition, administration, teaching, set design, playwriting, costume design.
- Completed 30 credits by the end of winter quarter 2006
- Minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Include a list of performing arts projects you've worked on.
- Current Highline student

Carino Family Scholarship - \$600

- High School Completion Student
- Must have been enrolled the quarter prior to the quarter applying for
- Last quarter GPA must be above 2.5
- Student must submit a 1-2 page essay showing that he/she is ready to successfully complete his/her high school diploma

Gladys Hart Memorial Nursing Scholarship - \$500

- Enrolled in the Nursing Program
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Maintain a minimum of 12-credit class load

Higline Math Department Scholarship - \$750

- Strong interest in mathematics
- Plan to take three quarters of mathematics, at a level of 124 or above.
Minimum 3.0 GPA

Ruth Murphy Evans Nursing Scholarship – \$2,000

- Enrolled in the Nursing Program
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Maintain a minimum of 12

- Enrolled in the HCC Accounting program for a minimum of 12 credits
